Biographical Background.

Valerian Nikolaev (03.02.1951), Doctor of Medical Sciences, Editorial Board Member of the Siberian Research journal. He has 81 scientific publications in eLibrary journals, 2 monographs. His articles have been cited 120 times, h-index: 5. Areas of expertise: phthysiology, healthcare organization, history of medicine. He is actively engaged in promoting scientific knowledge. He has 14 popular scientific publications on the history of health care and medical science.

He was born in Kangalassky nasleg of the Suntar District. 1976 – graduated from the medical department of the Yakutsk State University. 1976-1980 – worked as a resident, chief physician of the Pokrovsk interdistrict tuberculosis hospital. 1981-1987 – studied in clinical residency and graduate school at the Moscow Research Institute of Tuberculosis, Ministry of Health of the RSFSR. 1987-1992 – worked in the Yakutsk Research Institute of Tuberculosis of the Ministry of Health of the RSFSR;

1992-1994 – First Deputy Minister of Health of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia);

1994-2000 – Deputy Director for Scientific Work of ‘Phthysiopulmonology’ of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation;

2001-2009 – academic secretary, Deputy Director for Science, Yakutsk Scientific Center of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences and the Government of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), stood at the origins of its formation. He initiated the establishment of Yakutsk Medical Journal (2003), the first professional science-to-practice periodical in the republic.

2010 – co-authored the series “Famous Personalities of Health Care, Medical Science and Education of Yakutia”, with 9 books published.
